

Electronic Visit Verification (EVV)

Preparing for next steps with EVV

Electronic Visit Verification, or EVV, is a way of electronically verifying your clock in and clock out times as a worker in your program. EVV is required if you provide personal care or supportive home care services in the Family Care program.

Please be advised that both EVV visits and a timesheet is required for EVV services.

Need to get started with EVV?

Review the steps below for how to get set up with EVV.



Be sure to regularly check your email!

1. Make sure you provide iLIFE with your most up-to-date email address.*

- Click here for the online form: <https://ecm.mcfi.net/Forms/emailsubmission>
- This email address is where workers will receive important information on EVV, including EVV ID information necessary to log EVV visits.
- This email address is also where workers will receive the automated Sandata email to set up their Sandata Mobile Connect (SMC) account if they qualify for EVV. Please note that the email address will be the username.
- *Email must be unique to a single worker. It cannot be shared by multiple workers.

2. Determine which EVV options you will use.

- The three methods of submitting EVV are Mobile Visit Verification (MVV) through a software application called Sandata Mobile Connect (SMC), which is accessible on a smart device; Telephonic Visit Verification (TVV), which uses the client's landline phone; or Fixed Visit Verification (FVV), which utilizes a small device that stays at the client's home.
