




Electronic Visit Verification, or EVV, is required in Wisconsin! As your fiscal employer agent, iLIFE uses KanTime to seamlessly integrate EVV and timesheet information in three different ways.

EVV Option	Description	Recommended for
 <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <h3>KanTime Mobile App</h3> </div>	<p>Workers can use the KanTime mobile app to submit EVV and timesheet information in one! It works on a smart phone or tablet — even if there’s no internet.</p> <p>Note: You will need to be able to access the internet at least once a pay period before the timesheet due date.</p>	<p>For employees who have smartphones or tablets.</p> <p>-or-</p> <p>For employers who have smartphones or tablets that the employees can use to clock in and out.</p>
 <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <h3>Telephony (Phone Check-In)</h3> </div>	<p>Workers can also use a toll-free phone number on the employer’s landline/VoIP phone to check in, check out, and record their visits.</p>	<p>For employers who have a traditional landline or VoIP phones.</p>
 <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <h3>FOB Device</h3> </div>	<p>*The FOB device is a last resort option for meeting EVV requirements. Before requesting this device, you must speak with iLIFE to determine whether it is the right option for you.</p> <p>A FOB is a small device used in the home. It gives an 8-digit code that records the worker’s visit time and date.</p>	<p>When the other two EVV options are not possible.</p> <p>Note: The employer and/or employee must have access to Internet and computer to enter the codes in at least once a pay period before the timesheet due date. If you do not have this access, please contact iLIFE for an alternative option.</p>

Please note: Live-in workers are not required to participate in EVV. For the purposes of EVV, a live-in worker is a worker who permanently resides in the same residence as the member or participant receiving services. Proof of shared residence is required. - Make sure you submit your email address* and live-in status to iLIFE, using the links below, to receive an EVV ID. ***Email must be unique to a single worker. It cannot be shared by multiple workers.**
